Fancy a cup of coffee and a sticky bun?
Then this is the one for you!
Half hour run up to Beechworth, famous
for its Jail, Mayday Hills asylum, the
1850s Gold rush, bakery, lolly shop,
Woolshed Falls, the Gorge, Lake Sambell
etc, not necessarily in that order. Beechworth
likes tourists, and motor cyclists
are always very welcome. After you
have sampled all those delights you'll
need another ride to clear your head. So
Stanley (the place, not the person) is
next.

Very big on fruit growing, berries, chestnuts
etc. and in season, products are
available at roadside stalls. The road
down to Mudgegonga is fully sealed, but
caution is recommended as there are
some tight bends and possibly leaf litter
etc on the road.

No such problem once down the hill for
an easy trip to Dederang, home to the famous
Dederang Picnic Race Club. The
Kiewa Valley Hwy will take you back to
Wodonga and the whole trip is about
